# Sew Much Fun Northwest

May 1-6, 2012

Hosted by former Sew News editor Linda Griepentrog and writer Pauline Richards, Sew Much Fun Northwest is designed to share with you some of the region's fabric and sewing-related shopping and learning opportunities. Plus, we'll visit the beautiful Oregon Coast (and two fabric stores).

In addition to the organized portions of the tour, you will have some free time to explore the city's downtown on your own with a list of our favorite places to shop.

**Dates:** Meet us in Portland on Tuesday, May 1, 2012 in time for a 6pm orientation meeting at the hotel. We'll have a noted guest speaker from the sewing industry to kick off the week's activities. Depart Sunday, May 6 at your leisure.

**Lodging:** We'll stay at the Red Lion Inn, centrally located to restaurants, shopping and Portland's easy to ride transit system, MAX. If you plan to arrive before Tuesday or stay beyond Sunday, we can make rooming arrangements for you.

**Cost:** \$1,425 for ASG members, double occupancy (non-members \$1,525), includes five nights lodging, all tour events and transportation, two lunches, guest speakers, farewell dinner, all taxes and gratuities and door prizes.

**Activities:** We plan to visit the Pati Palmer's sewing room, Pendleton Woolen Mill (for shopping and a mill tour), Fabric Depot (73,000 square feet of fabric!), Rose City Textiles, Mill End Store, Woolen Mill Store, Portland's famed Saturday Market and a local artist studio. Some stores will offer our group special discounts. At the Oregon Coast, we'll visit two fabric stores and enjoy the beautiful town of Cannon Beach.

Note: The tour does include some walking.
